



TEACHER NOTES BIBLE OVERVIEW ASSIGNMENT

In 2011 a group of students in Melbourne were given the following challenge:

Instructions

This semester you have been learning how the 66 books of the Bible, written over 1500 years, tell one epic story. Your task in this assignment is to tell that story in a way that captivates the imagination of people your age and helps them to learn more about the Bible's storyline.

You will need to create a PowerPoint, Prezi, animation or short film that tells the Bible's story from start to end capturing the major events and developments that occur within it.

There are three things that you must use in your presentation to help tell the Bible's story: text, images and Bible verses.

Step 1: Plan the style of presentation that you will create.

Your presentation should include both the well known and the more confronting and challenging parts of the Bible's story!

Step 2: Map out the story

The challenge of this assignment is to bring the big events of the Bible together and capture how they connect and how the story develops. Don't spend a long time on the detail of your presentation until you have mapped out the story from start to end.

Step 3: Choose pictures/artwork and verses from the Bible

You need to choose appropriate pictures that help people engage with the story you are telling. Key Bible verses will also help to reinforce the story.

Step 4: Finalise your presentation and hand it in on time

You will need to ensure that all images/artwork are referenced.
